Cressex BID is organising a Team Up to Clean Up event in conjunction with a local waste management provider. Our aim is to conduct an initial site wide 'clean up' followed by regular community led events. These activities will be in addition to the on-going street cleaning works undertaken by the Local Authority.

This event is part of the BID's wider strategy in working to maintain and improve the general condition and appearance of roads, footpaths and grass verges.

Volunteers must be 18 years or older to participate in this event and participation is at volunteers' own risk.

Guidelines

Please read the following guidelines prior to taking part in any litter picking activity:

1. Where possible work in pairs;
2. Wear appropriate clothing, shoes, gloves and hi vis;
3. Use litter pickers to collect waste into a suitable refuse bag;
4. Do not attempt to collect litter from the middle of the road;
5. Do not collect the following items:
 - Broken glass
 - Syringes
 - Any biological waste products including dog faeces
6. Make a note of the location and contact the BID team and/or report to Fix My Street www.fixmystreet.buckscc.gov.uk
7. Do not carry heavy bags, there are a limited number of litter trolleys please advise if you would like to use one of these;
8. Do not continue to work in adverse weather conditions;
9. Do not put yourself or others in any compromising situations, if necessary stop what you are doing and leave the area;
10. Carry hand sanitiser and wash your hands thoroughly at the end of your litter pick;
11. Seal completed bag and either use an available bin or leave next to a public bin and advise the Cressex BID team of the location on 07850310592 or e-mail margaret.mccarthy@groundwork.org.uk;
12. When finished, please take a photo of your team (where applicable) and rubbish collected and send it to margaret.mccarthy@groundwork.org.uk or upload onto the litter picking page of the Cressex Business Park website www.cressexbid.co.uk/litter-picking
